Certificate III in Visual Arts (partial completion) (CUA31120)

PROGRAM DESCRIPTION

This program is designed for further study in all visual and creative art fields, and concentrates on creative thinking, design principles and arts practice theory. It explores drawing techniques including observational drawing, 2D studies including painting and printmaking techniques, 3D studies and photo media (Adobe Photoshop). All teachers of the course are practicing artists who bring years of creative thinking and practice to the classroom.

WHO SHOULD APPLY?

Students who are interested creative studies. This program can help you find your niche or simply broaden your artistic horizons.

PROGRAM STRUCTURE

2 year program

Delivered one afternoon a week with 1-week block delivery during school holidays

Location: SWTAFE Warrnambool, Portland, Hamilton and Colac Campuses

PATHWAYS

Pathways include Certificate IV in Visual Arts, Diploma of Visual Arts or Diploma of Photography.

VCE SUBJECTS

It is recommended that the following units be undertaken:

- English units 1 and 4
- Art units 1 to 4

WORK PLACEMENTS

The VCAA strongly recommends a minimum 5 days of work placement for this program.

CONTRIBUTION TO THE VCE

Students undertaking Certificate III in Visual Arts are eligible for credit of up to four VCE VET units on their VCE Statement of Results: two units at Unit 1-2 level and a Unit 3-4 sequence.

Students may be entitled to 10% increment towards their VCE.

BENEFITS

- Completion of both VCE and VET certificates
- Possible credits from other TAFE courses
- Contribution toward VCE units 1-4
- Opportunity to undertake work placement
- Accredited entry level for other TAFE and university courses
- Pathways to further training
