Certificate II in Building and Construction Pre-apprenticeship (partial completion)

PROGRAM DESCRIPTION

The Building and Construction program is designed to provide the skills required for a successful career in building and construction. This program provides a taste of what the building industry is like as a career. It also provides a wide variety of experience in using tools while developing skills and techniques and provides a partial completion of the Certificate II in Building and Construction pre- apprenticeship program. Units include safe handling of plant and power tools, quality principles for the building industry, calculations, wall and roof framing, building structures, setting out and workplace documents and plans.

WHO SHOULD APPLY?

People working in trades are in high demand. This program will provide students interested in the building industry with a sound basis for employment. Careers include Carpenter, Fixing Carpenter, Formwork Carpenter, Joiner, Cabinet maker, Bricklayer or Builder.

PATHWAYS

Pathways include: Certificate III in Carpentry (apprenticeship), Certificate III in Cabinet Making (apprenticeship), Certificate IV in Building and Construction.

- Design and Technology units 1 to 4
- General Maths units 1 to 4
- Physical Education units 1 to 4
- Graphics units 1 to 4

WORK PLACEMENTS

The VCAA strongly recommends a minimum of 80 hours of work placement for this program.

CONTRIBUTION TO THE VCE

The units in this program have been grouped to form Unit 1-2 and Unit 3-4 sequences for VCE or VCE VM recognition purposes.

Students may be entitled to 10% increment towards their VCE.

- Possible credits from other TAFE courses
- Contribution toward VCE units 1-4
- Opportunity to undertake work placement
- Accredited entry level for other TAFE and University courses
